KIDS CAN KNOW GOD CONFERENCES

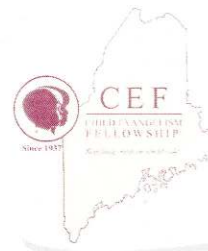
Praise for good results from each conference even though attendance was lower.
