Last Friday evening I drove to Hancock for our Eastern Maine committee meeting. It was an encouraging time as we heard of three children coming to know our Lord in a *Good News Club*®, and of a brand new club starting on Mt. Desert Island. I do not believe we have ever, at least in my twenty-five years, had a *Good News Club* on Mt. Desert Island. I traveled a long way back to Livermore that evening, on some snowy roads, but with a thankful heart for what God is doing in Eastern Maine.

All over Maine our Lord is at work as His Word goes out to children and teens in clubs and at camps. Your generosity helps to make that possible.
