BLUEBERRY MOUNTAIN BIBLE CAMP

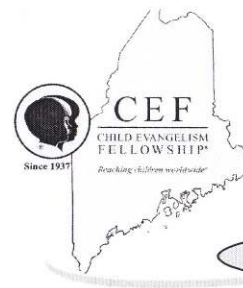
Pray for at least 20 campers to sign up for each of the three weeks. 46 campers have signed up as of the beginning of this month.
