BLUEBERRY MOUNTAIN BIBLE CAMP

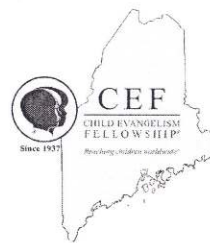
Praise that the camp passed inspection! Pray the needed changes will get finished.

Our Lord is entrusting us with the lives of these young men and young women. After *CYIA™* many of the young people will serve with us in various capacities throughout our summer ministry.
