Dear Friend,

In his closing remarks to the Corinthians, Paul wrote of a great open door for ministry. "But I will tarry in Ephesus until Pentecost. For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries" (I Cor. 16:9).

We are conducting *Good News Clubs*® in a growing number of schools all across Maine. As of the end of January, we were bringing the Gospel to children in sixty-eight public elementary schools. God has truly opened a "great and effective door." Over eleven hundred children attend those clubs; fifty-four children have made professions of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. But "there are many adversaries."

Recently in New York State, the courts ruled that Sunday worship services could not be held in public schools. At this present time there is a distinction being made between a "worship service," and a gathering of kids to sing praises to God, pray together, and hear a Bible lesson at a *Good News Club*. No one knows how long that distinction will remain intact.

I ask you to pray that God would keep this door open, and that He would raise up the needed laborers to bring the message of salvation into many more schools, while there is still time.

And I thank you for giving so generously to the ministry of *Child Evangelism Fellowship*®. "When the enemy comes in like a flood, The Spirit of the LORD will lift up a standard against him" (Isa. 59:19b).
