Dear Friend,

We are living at a time when information is accessible almost immediately. If you do not know the answer to something, just "Google" it. Even my seven year old grandson uses an "I Phone." It is amazing that in this information age, where kids know so much, they know so little of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. There are many children who have no idea of who He is, or of what He has accomplished on their behalf.

I spent a little time this year at our Chapel on Wheels, at the Fryeburg Fair. I was very encouraged while watching a couple of young people sharing the Gospel with children, and with the adults who brought them. When asked if they owned a Bible, not one of them answered "yes." Most kids have no idea of who God really is. They do not attend Sunday School or go to church. In this age of readily available information, most children are truly ignorant of spiritual truth.

I am thankful that we still have our ministry at the fairs throughout Maine. I am thankful for those dedicated volunteers who serve with our staff, making that ministry possible. I am thankful for all of you who give and pray that we might continue to bring the Gospel to the children of Maine.

Those kids I mentioned earlier did not make a profession of faith. I believe they were hearing the Gospel for the very first time. Please continue in prayer that God would open eyes and open hearts, that children might be saved. The need is great, the work is difficult, but God is able. Thank you and God bless you.
