In October we held our annual corporation meeting and heard reports from *CEF* staff from all around our state. This past ministry year was both challenging and fruitful. Three hundred twenty children that we know of made professions of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Those decisions were made in clubs, in fairs, in VBS, at various camping ministries, and in open air evangelism. One of those who made a decision was a young exchange student from Germany who trusted the Lord Jesus as her own Savior. Only God can bring a child from Germany to Weld, Maine in order to hear the gospel and come to know the Savior. Every child who trusted the Lord during this past year, has his own special story. Even a young mother was lead to the Lord by one of our young people during *CYIA*. I heard testimony of 4 teens who came to one of our fairs, heard the gospel and all 4 trusted the Savior.

There are thousands more children to reach here in Maine. We are working and praying towards establishing 100 Christmas Party Clubs in the month of December. We are going to teach those clubs where we do not already have a *CEF* ministry. Please pray with us that our God would open doors and grant much fruit.

Your financial support, and your ministry of prayer are absolutely essential to the work of evangelizing and discipling the children of Maine. *"It is not the will of your Father that one of these little ones should perish"* (Matt 18:14).

I cannot say thank you enough. We appreciate your gift; we appreciate your prayers; we appreciate your help; and we appreciate you. This is God's work, and this is the work that He has entrusted to all of us. Thank you for doing that part which He has given to you.

## Prayer and Praise

### SUMMER MINISTRIES

- 41 5-Day Clubs/VBS's were conducted with 622 attending
- 14 Fairs & Festivals were attended with 2644 children hearing the Gospel.
- 77 children contacted in the Open Air ministries.
- 12 weeks of Day Camps were conducted with 538 children attending
- 10 weeks of overnight camping were held with 675 children attending.
- Praise for a total of 165 children who received Christ in all these ministries.
