EASTERN MAINE CHAPTER

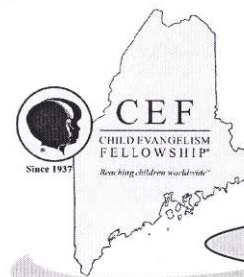
Praise for our Eastern Maine worker, Jessie Lofton who has now completed her first year of ministry.
